Manual transmissions were the standard on most vehicle for the first half of the 20th century, but automatic transmissions were being developed as far back as 1904. General Motors introduced the clutchless automatic transmission under the moniker, Hydra-Matic, in 1938, but the first true fully automatic transmission didn't appear until 1948 with the Buick Dynaflo transmission.

The introduction of the automatic transmission did this by offering a "no-muss, no-fuss" form of shifting. The earliest automobiles offered only manual transmissions, which were similar in principle to today's stick-shift vehicles. These cars sported two forward gears and one reverse, coupled to the engine via a series of pedals.
