The first signs of widespread political dissent in Russia surfaced nearly a century before the Russian Revolution, following the death of Tsar Alexander I in December 1825. Ever since the War of 1812, many Russians, especially military personnel who had served abroad, were inspired by growing democratic movements in Europe.
